CMS Hasche Sigle advises the towns of Friedrichshafen and Überlingen on establishing the "Stadtwerk am See" municipal utility company

Stuttgart – Municipal utility companies Technische Werke Friedrichshafen GmbH and Stadtwerke Überlingen GmbH have merged their energy, water supply, telecommunications and infrastructure services into a newly established joint company. The new municipal utility company is called "Stadtwerk am See GmbH & Co. KG" and is headquartered in Überlingen.
