## Luxembourg investor acquires solar project from WIRSOL Solar AG

Hamburg – Solar Infrastructure Holding S.à.r.l. has acquired a solar park constructed by WIRSOL Solar AG on a former military airfield in Luckau, in the Federal State of Brandenburg. The Luckau solar park with total nominal capacity of around 21 megawatts peak (MWp) has been connected to the grid since the end of 2011 and was officially opened on 11 January 2012.

A team from CMS Hasche Sigle led by Dr Niklas Ganssaug advised WIRSOL Solar AG on acquisition of the project rights, development of the project, obtaining external finance and finally selling the Luckau solar park to Solar Infrastructure Holding S.à.r.l.
