Stuttgart – Hamburg-based investor CAPCELLENCE has acquired a majority of the shares in 4WHEELS Service + Logistik GmbH, Düsseldorf. Heinz and Robin Vogl, the founders of 4Wheels Service + Logistik GmbH, and family office OBROSI GmbH & Co. KG retain an equity interest. The previous private equity investor has sold its 38% stake in the company and is no longer a shareholder. The undisclosed purchase price was raised exclusively through equity capital.
