CMS Hasche Sigle advises Cordea Savills German Retail Fund on sale of retail property in Offenburg

Stuttgart – The Cordea Savills German Retail Fund has sold an inner-city retail property in Offenburg to Hamborner REIT AG, a listed public limited company operating in the property sector. Refurbished in 2008/2009, the building has a total rental area of some 5,000 square metres which is leased to the Müller chain. The transaction volume was EUR 7.9 million.
