He is a recognised jurist not only for his professional career but also for his teaching activity at the *Centro de Estudios Legales* and ICADE, among others, and in 2018 he was awarded the *Cruz Distintivo Blanco* from the National Police and in 2007 he was given the *Cruz de Primera de Raimundo y Peñafort*.

Furthermore, he is the author of numerous monographs and articles on tax crimes.

Commenting on this appointment, Managing Partner César Albiñana, says: "we are proud that Enrique Remón, a professional of such impeccable profile and quality, with a clear career progression, chooses to join our firm.
