Requirements for ambassadors

Second- to sixth-year law students from universities for potential cooperation:

- Ukrainian Catholic University
- Kyiv School of Economics
- Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv
- Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute
- Yaroslav Mudryi National Law University
- Ivan Franko National University of Lviv



The average grade for the previous semester/academic year should be at least grade A (90-100 points)



You cannot be an ambassador for other law firms



Active user of social media: at least 500 followers on LinkedIn, Instagram, Facebook or TikTok



You should have enough free time for the ambassadorship (2-3 hours per week)



High student activity: participation in moot courts, student organizations, etc.



You need to be proficient in both writing and speaking in English and Ukrainian.



Ambassadors' activities

- Promote CMS to students, career offices and local organisations
- Participate in CMS ambassadors' meetings and corporate events
- Support the promotion of CMS in social media (1-2 posts per week)
- Support organising CMS events in university
- Participation in CMS's work experience programme for 2-3 weeks in Ukraine
- Duration of the role is a minimum of 12 months



Selection process

- Complete the online application form and send a three-minute video in which you explain why you would like to be a CMS Ambassador and how you would deliver this (in English)
- The second stage of the selection process will be a video interview. We will invite the best candidates to a video interview with the Chief and Internal Ambassadors
- Onboarding (office tour and presentation about CMS)



Ambassador's programme

- Monthly meetings with the CMS Chief and Internal Ambassadors
- Webinar for external ambassadors with one of the practice groups quarterly
- CMS work experience programme with one of our practice groups
- Rewards for the most active ambassadors: employment opportunities, prizes for activities, etc.
