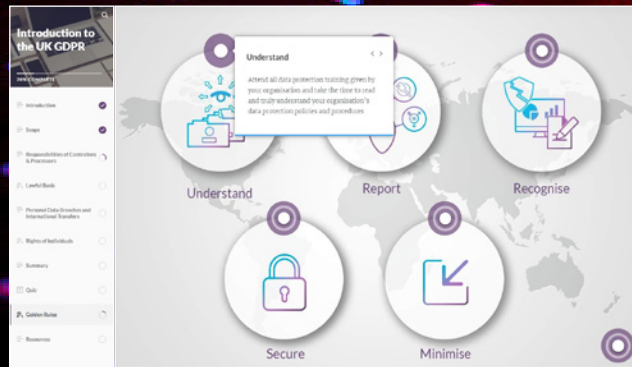

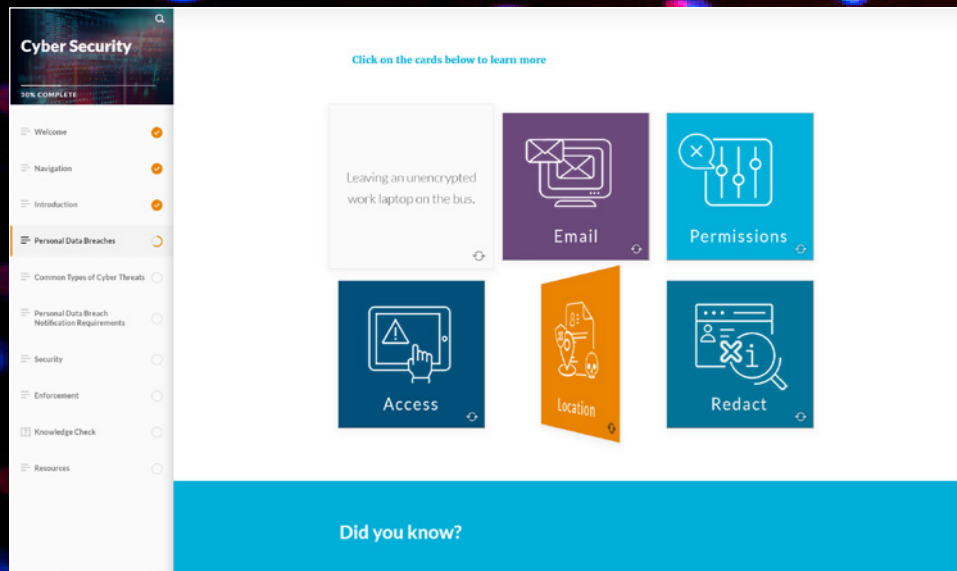

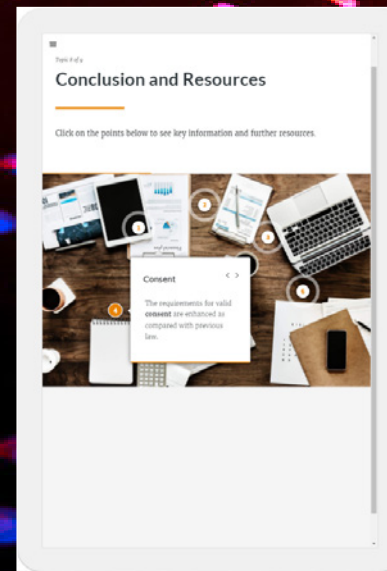
Quizzes

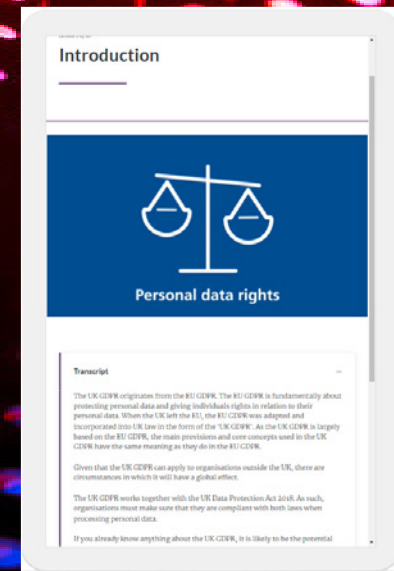
